On the above date and time, I responded to the Brain Institute in reference to several individuals attempting to gain access to the locked building under false pretenses. Upon arrival, I observed an Asian male sitting on the wall next to the entrance. I introduced myself and explained why I was there. The individual, later identified as stated he observed the individuals described attempting to swipe into the Brain Institute using what he mought was a UF ID. Chan stated that when they could not access the building, the group started walking south on Newell Drive towards the rear of the building. At this time, I relayed this information to Communications and began walking to the rear entrance of the Brain Institute.

While enroute, Ofc. Holmes ID#70 stated that he observed the individuals near the loading dock area of the building. Upon arrival, I made contact with Ofc. Holmes and Inv. Hale ID#41, who were already out with the individuals. Ofc. Holmes was attempting to get identification from the individuals, but all stated that they did not have ID's on them. The individuals were informed that if they did not have identification, that their information could be checked using their names and DOB's. At this time, several members of the group stated that they were uncomfortable providing any information. Inv. Hale informed the group that they were being legally detained and that they did not have a choice and needed to identify themselves. After explaining this to them repeatedly, the ones with some type of identification provided their identification. After identification was obtained from four members of the group, I obtained a name and DOB from one of the remaining members without ID. The individual was identified as DOB 10/17/87. I ran this information through Communications with negative results.

This concludes my involvement in this case.

Upon arrival, I witnessed a group of 6 people walking along the south side of the building. As I approached in my marked patrol vehicle, I observed the group walk towards the building and attempt to open the door of a clearly marked mechanical room. I stopped and gave the group a command to come to me and explain their presence. One of the group stated they had an appointment in the building and were trying to find a way in. When asked if they had permission to enter the building, stated he had made arrangements to hold a meeting on 10/28/13 in a room in the building. He could not provide a reason for their attempting to gain access today. Officers Motes, Boland, Investigator Hale, and Sgt. Konopka arrived on scene. When asked for identification, had to be asked twice before he would produce his ID; the rest of the group took several verbal commands before identification was finally given.

gain entry through the front doors. Upon arrival, I contacted Ofc. Boland and asked her to record this incident with her in-car recorder (vehicle 5).

One U.F. student and five non- U.F. students were trying to gain access to the locked up U.F. Brain Institute.

First, the U.F. student "attempted to use his UFID card to swipe in to unlock the front doors without success."

Secondly, two employees leaving the Brain Institute observed an Asian male with the group grab onto the door before it shut to hold it open to gain access. (employee) interrupted the Asian male and told him there were cameras inside and he was not allowed to gain access (see sworn statement).

Third, another complainant who made contact with UFPD Communications (page 150) advised that the only woman (page 150) in the group told her that she had left her backpack inside the Brain Institute and she needed to be let in the building to retrieve it. UFPD.

Lastly, when officers responded to the call, Ofc. Holmes witnessed some members of the group attempting to gain access (by trying the handle) in a back side mechanical room on the southeast corner of the Brain Institute.

After officers made contact with the group, the officers received resistance from the group showing identification and asking what was their intentions trying to get into the Brain Institute.

When I was on scene, I asked the group what you were doing here today? The female identified as said we have an event here coming up and we wanted to check out the area. A few minutes later, I asked the group what were their intentions were if they did gain access to the building? All members of the group then silenced and would not comment on their intentions. I heard Ofc. Boland advise the entire group that the Brain Institute did not have any rooms for their event on Monday and that the person who arranged for the room to be reserved "was notified by mail of the cancellation. The group was not happy to hear that their event was canceled and advised that they had a couple of hundred people coming to this event. Ofc. Boland told the group that they needed to contact them by FACEBOOK or whatever social networking site they use to notify them of this cancellation. Someone from the group asked who would stop them if people showed up for this event. Ofc. Boland advised staff of the building would advise people looking for the meeting that the meeting was canceled.

Based on all events that occurred today and the fact that members attempted to gain access to a secured building by deception, I requested all subjects not affiliated with U.F. be trespassed from all of U.F. campus and U.F. Health. I requested the the U.F. student "to be trespassed from the UF Health area only. The on-call dean was notified. Capt. Rice and Det. Moran were advised of this incident.
